**Description:** C-Reactive Protein (CRP) is a pentameric serum protein belonging to the pentraxin

family. It is a positive acute phase reactant, the levels of which increase modestly in

dogs (1.5-2 fold) in response to inflammation, tissue injury or disease.

**Concentration:** 0.4 mg/ml

Source: Canine Serum

**Molecular Weight:** Comprised of five identical ~ 23 kDa subunits.

Formulation: Liquid in 0.05 M Tris buffer containing 0.15 M Sodium Chloride + 0.002 M Calcium

Chloride + 0.02% Sodium Azide, pH 8.0. Precaution: Sodium azide is a poisonous and

hazardous substance which should be handled by trained staff only.

**Purity:** >96% by SDS-PAGE

**Purification:** Affinity chromotography

Storage & Stability: Store at ≤-20°C.
