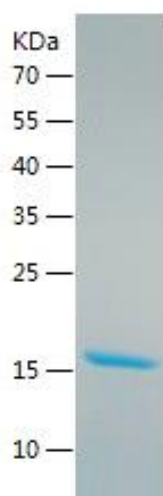

Activity:	Measured in a cytotoxicity assay using L-929 mouse fibroblast cells in the presence of the metabolic inhibitor actinomycin. The ED50 for this effect is 0.1-0.3 ng/mL.
Formulation:	Lyophilized from a 0.2 μm filtered solution in 10 mM Hepes, 150 mM NaCl with 5% trehalose, pH7.4.
Reconstitution:	Centrifuge the vial before opening, reconstitute in sterile distilled water to a concentration of 0.1-1 mg/ml by gently pipetting 2-3 times, don't vortex.

Storage:

The lyophilized protein is stable at -20 °C for up to 1 year. After reconstitution, the protein solution is stable at -20 to -80 °C for 3 months or 1 week at 2 to 8 °C under sterile conditions. For extended storage, it is recommended to further dilute in working aliquots, avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycle.
