Molecular Characterization

Poly-his

This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus

The protein has a calculated MW of 37.6 kDa. The protein migrates as 45-66 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.

Endotoxin

Less than $1.0\ EU$ per μg by the LAL method.

Purity

>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Formulation

Lyophilized from 0.22 μm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4 with trehalose as protectant.

Storage


For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower.

Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

This product is stable after storage at:

- -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state;
- -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

SDS-PAGE



Human CNTF R alpha, His Tag on SDS-PAGE under reducing (R) condition. The gel was stained overnight with Coomassie Blue. The purity of the protein is greater than 95%.

Background

Ciliary neurotrophic factor receptor subunit alpha (CNTFR or CNTFR-alpha) belongs to the type I cytokine receptor family and type 3 subfamily. CNTFR contains two fibronectin type-III domains and one Ig-like C2-type (immunoglobulin-like) domain. This receptor and its cognate ligand support the survival of neurons. This receptor is most closely related to the interleukin-6 receptor. This receptor possesses an unusual attachment to the cell membrane through a glycophosphatidylinositol linkage.
