AAV6 VP3, Recombinant Protein(VP3-A5146) is expressed from E. coli cells. It contains AA Met 203 - Leu 736 (Accession # <u>O56137-1</u>).

Predicted N-terminus: Met

#### **Molecular Characterization**

This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus.

The protein has a calculated MW of 61.6 kDa. The protein migrates as 58-63 kDa when calibrated against <u>Star Ribbon Pre-stained Protein Marker</u> under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE).

# **Purity**

>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from 0.22  $\mu m$  filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4 with trehalose as protectant.

#### Storage


For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower.

Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

This product is stable after storage at:

- -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state;
- -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

# Background

Adeno-associated virus is a single-stranded DNA virus and the current scientific consensus is that it does not cause any human disease. It consists of a protein capsid (CAPside) and a 4.7 KB length single stranded DNA genome. The protein capsid consists of three subunits, VP1, VP2, and VP3.
