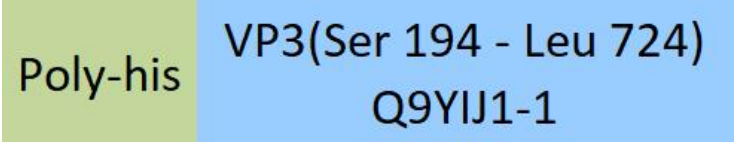

AAV5 VP3, Recombinant Protein(VP3-A5147) is expressed from E. coli cells. It contains AA Ser 194 - Leu 724 (Accession # [Q9YIJ1-1](#)).

Predicted N-terminus: Met

Molecular Characterization



This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus.

The protein has a calculated MW of 61.4 kDa. The protein migrates as 60-65 kDa when calibrated against [Star Ribbon Pre-stained Protein Marker](#) under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE).

Purity

>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Formulation

Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS with trehalose as protectant.

Storage

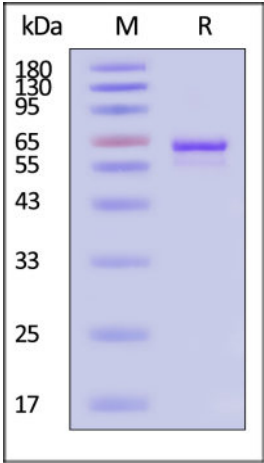
For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower.

*Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.*

This product is stable after storage at:

- -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state;
- -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Background

Adeno-associated virus is a single-stranded DNA virus and the current scientific consensus is that it does not cause any human disease. It consists of a protein capsid (CAPside) and a 4.7 KB length single stranded DNA genome. The protein capsid consists of three subunits, VP1, VP2, and VP3.
