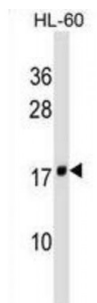


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NADH-Ubiquinone Oxidoreductase Chain 4L (ND4L) Antibody

Core subunit of the mitochondrial membrane respiratory chain NADH dehydrogenase (Complex I) that is believed to belong to the minimal assembly required for catalysis. Complex I functions in the transfer of electrons from NADH to the respiratory chain. The immediate electron acceptor for the enzyme is believed to be ubiquinone (By similarity).

Target: ND4L

Reactivity: Human

Host: Rabbit

Clonality: Polyclonal

Tested Applications: WB

Recommended dilutions: Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.

Immunogen: Human ND4L.

Purification: Peptide Affinity Purified Rabbit Polyclonal Antibody.

Isotype: IgG

Conjugation: Unconjugated

Specificity: This ND4L antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 65-93 amino acids from the C-terminal region of human ND4L.

Storage: Aliquot and store at -20 °C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Buffer: PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.
