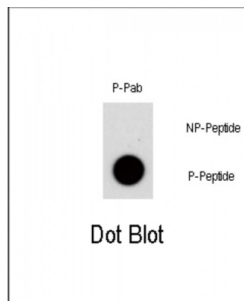


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NR4A1 (pS351) Antibody

NR4A1 is a member of the steroid-thyroid hormone-retinoid receptor superfamily. Expression is induced by phytohemagglutinin in human lymphocytes and by serum stimulation of arrested fibroblasts. The encoded protein acts as a nuclear transcription factor. Translocation of the protein from the nucleus to mitochondria induces apoptosis.

Target: NR4A1 (pS351)

Reactivity: Human

Recommended dilutions: Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.

Immunogen: Human NR4A1 (phospho-Ser351).

Purification: Peptide Affinity Purified Rabbit Polyclonal Antibody.

Isotype: IgG

Conjugation: Unconjugated

Specificity: This NR4A1 Antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic phosphopeptide corresponding to amino acid residues surrounding S351 of human NR4A1.

Storage: Aliquot and store at -20 °C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Buffer: PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by two-step phosphospecific peptide affinity purification.
