<u>Background</u>: TUBG1 (tubulin gamma 1) encodes a member of the tubulin superfamily. The encoded protein localizes to the centrosome where it binds to microtubules as part of a complex referred to as the gamma-tubulin ring complex. The protein mediates microtubule nucleation and is required for microtubule formation and progression of the cell cycle. A pseudogene of TUBG1 is found on chromosome 7.

<u>Application Notes</u>: Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Suggested starting dilutions are as follows: WB (1:1000-1:2000), IHC-P (1:100-1:200).

Storage Buffer: PBS containing 50% Glycerol, 0.5% BSA and 0.02% Sodium Azide.

Storage Instructions: Stable for one year at -20°C from date of shipment. For maximum recovery of product, centrifuge the original vial after thawing and prior to removing the cap. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.




Fig.1. Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffinembedded Human Colon Carcinoma Tissue using Gamma Tubulin Mouse mAb diluted at 1:200.






Fig.2. Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffinembedded Human Breast Carcinoma Tissue using Gamma Tubulin Mouse mAb diluted at 1:200.
