**Biotinylated Anti-Human G-CSF Antibody -
Additional Information****Preparation**

Produced from sera of rabbits pre-immunized with highly pure (>98%) recombinant hG-CSF. Anti-Human G-CSF specific antibody was purified by affinity chromatography and then biotinylated.

WesternBlot

To detect hG-CSF by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1 - 0.2 µg/ml. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant hG-CSF is 1.5 - 3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.

Sandwich

To detect hG-CSF by sandwich ELISA (using 100 µl/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.25 - 1.0 µg/ml of this antibody is required. This biotinylated polyclonal antibody, in conjunction with BioGems's Polyclonal Anti-Human G-CSF (60-158P) as a capture antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant hG-CSF.

Direct

To detect hG-CSF by direct ELISA (using 100 µl/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.25 - 1.0 µg/ml of this antibody is required. This biotinylated polyclonal antibody, in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents, allows the detection of at least 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant hG-CSF.

Formulation

A sterile filtered antibody solution was lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.2.

Reconstitution

Centrifuge vial prior to opening.

Reconstitute in sterile PBS containing 0.1% BSA to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

Storage

-20°C
