This TRAPPC3 antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 17-46 amino acids from the N-terminal region of human TRAPPC3.

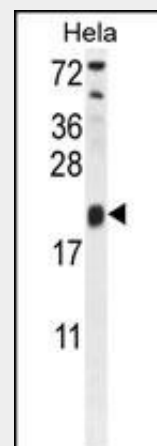

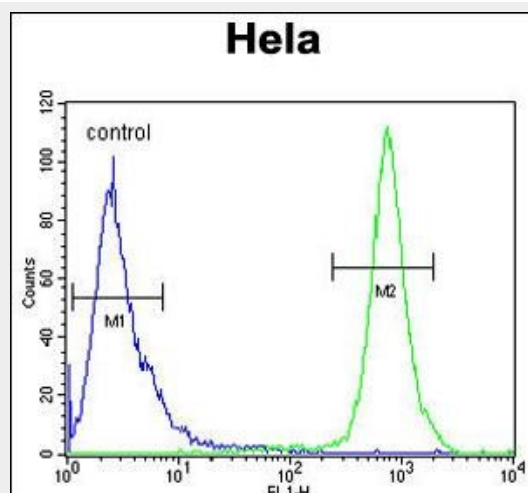
Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

May play a role in vesicular transport from endoplasmic reticulum to Golgi.

Cellular Location

Golgi apparatus, cis-Golgi network.
Endoplasmic reticulum

TRAPPC3 is a component of the TRAPP complex, which is involved in tethering of transport vesicles to the cis-Golgi membrane (Turnbull et al., 2005 [PubMed 15692564]).[supplied by OMIM].
