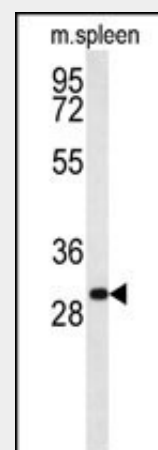
Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

Name RTP1

Synonyms Z3CXXC1

Function

Specifically promotes functional cell surface expression of olfactory receptors, but not of other GPCRs.

Cellular Location

Cell membrane; Single-pass type III membrane protein. Note=Effective cell surface expression depends upon interaction with olfactory receptors.

Tissue Location

Expressed in testis..
