Storage

Store at -20 °C for one year. Avoid repeated
freeze/thaw cycles. When reconstituted in
sterile pH 7.4 0.01M PBS or diluent of
antibody the antibody is stable for at least
two weeks at 2-4 °C.

Name ZNF263 ([HGNC:13056](#))

Function

Transcription factor that binds to the
consensus sequence 5'- TCCTCCC-3' and

acts as a transcriptional repressor (PubMed:32051553). Binds to the promoter region of SIX3 and recruits other proteins involved in chromatin modification and transcriptional corepression, resulting in methylation of the promoter and transcriptional repression (PubMed:32051553). Acts as transcriptional repressor of HS3ST1 and HS3ST3A1 via binding to gene promoter regions (PubMed:32277030).

Cellular Location

Nucleus.

Tissue Location

Expressed in heart, brain, placenta, lung, liver, skeletal muscle, kidney, pancreas, spleen, thymus, prostate, testis, ovary, small intestine, colon and leukocyte
