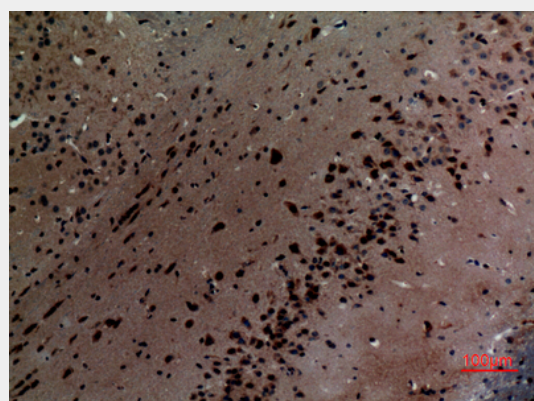
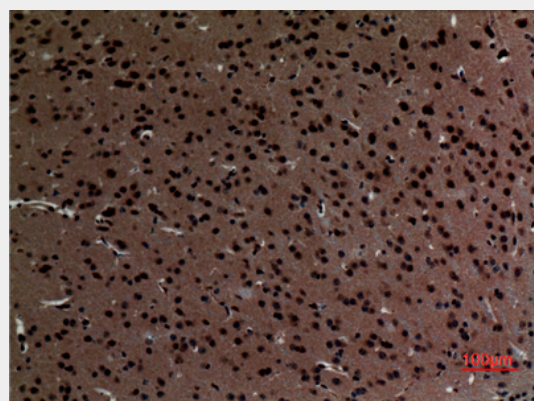
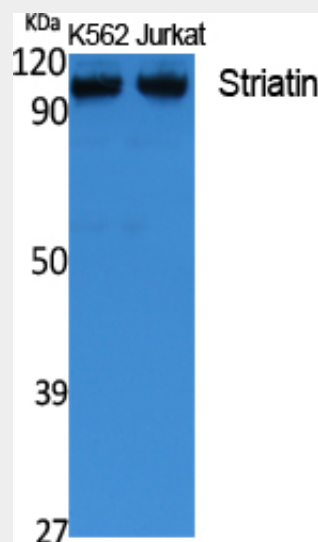
Function

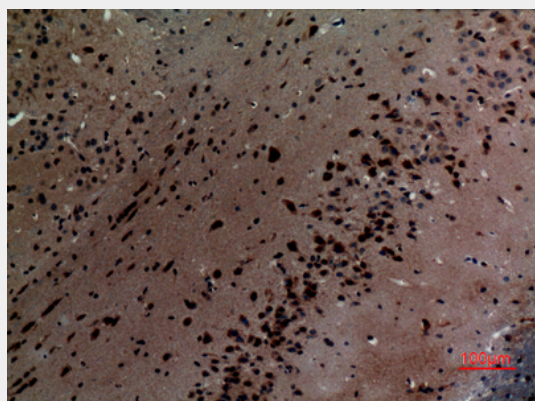
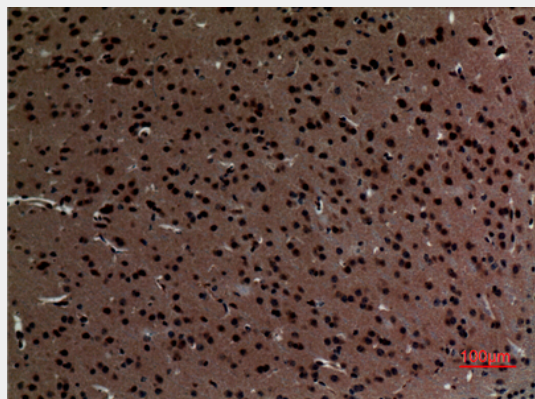
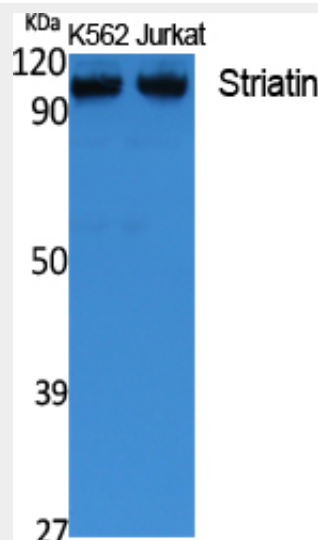
