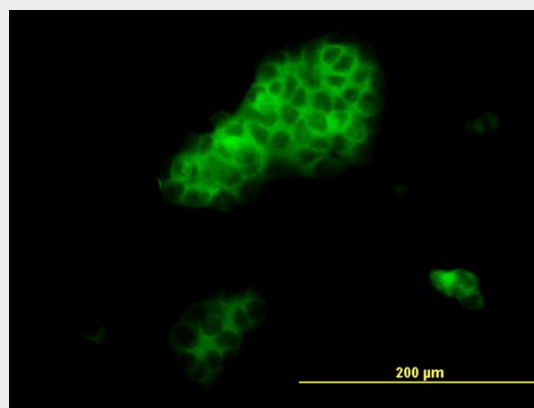
Storage

Store at -20°C or lower. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

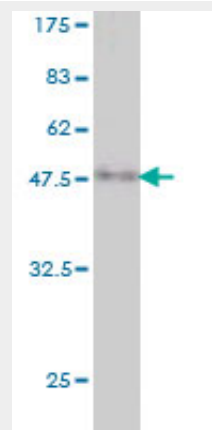

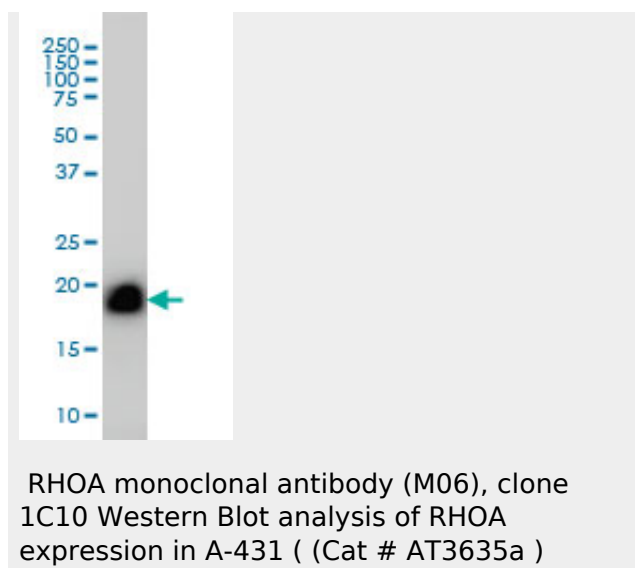
Immunofluorescence of monoclonal antibody to RHOA on A-431 cell. [antibody concentration 10 ug/ml]
