Clear, colorless solution in phosphate buffered saline, pH 7.2 .

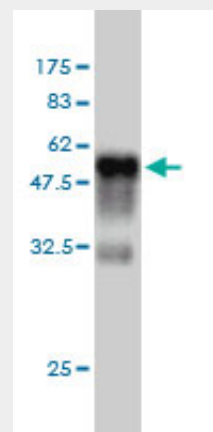
Storage

Store at -20°C or lower. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

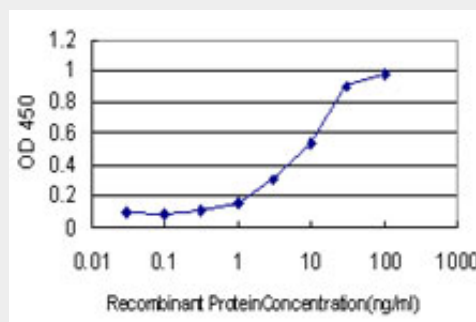

Detection limit for recombinant GST tagged RIT2 is approximately 0.3ng/ml as a capture antibody.
