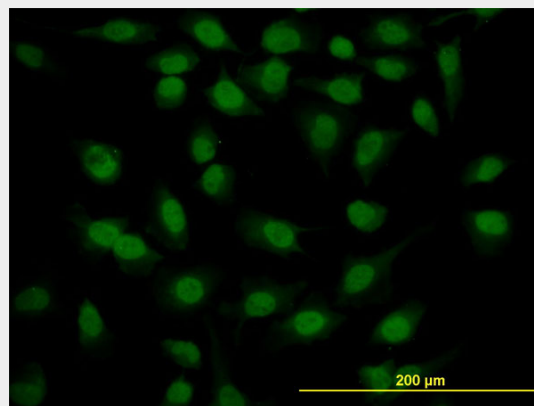

Storage

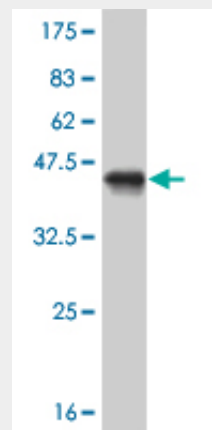
Store at -20°C or lower. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Immunofluorescence of monoclonal antibody to SURB7 on HeLa cell. [antibody concentration 10 ug/ml]

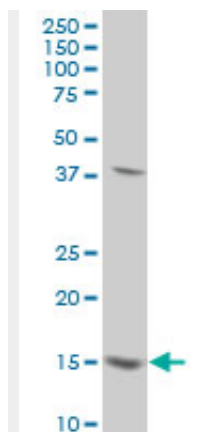


Antibody Reactive Against Recombinant Protein. Western Blot detection against Immunogen (41.58 KDa) .

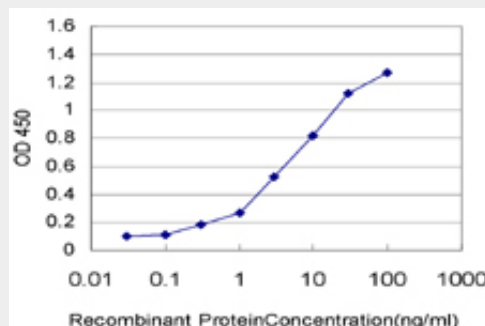
