
Storage

Store at -20°C or lower. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.



Antibody Reactive Against Recombinant Protein.Western Blot detection against Immunogen (36.52 KDa) .



Detection limit for recombinant GST tagged ULK2 is approximately 0.3ng/ml as a capture antibody.

ULK2 Antibody (monoclonal) (M01) - Background

This gene encodes a protein that is similar to a serine/threonine kinase in C. elegans which is involved in axonal elongation. The structure of this protein is similar to the C. elegans protein in that both proteins have an N-terminal kinase domain, a central proline/serine rich (PS) domain, and a C-terminal (C) domain. The gene is located within the Smith-Magenis syndrome region on chromosome 17. Alternatively spliced transcript variants
