May function in a signal transduction pathway that is activated by various cell stresses and leads to apoptosis.

Tissue Location

Isoform 2 and isoform 3 are widely

MEKK15 Antibody (C-term) Blocking peptide - Background

MEKK15 is a member of themitogen-activated protein kinase (MAPK) family. These familymembers function in a protein kinase signal transduction cascade, where an activated MAPK kinase kinase (MAP3K) phosphorylates and activates a specific MAPK kinase (MAP2K), which then activates aspecific MAPK. This MAP3K protein plays an essential role inapoptotic cell death triggered by cellular stresses. [provided byRefSeq].
