This RNF150 antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 60-87 amino acids from the N-terminal region of human RNF150.

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

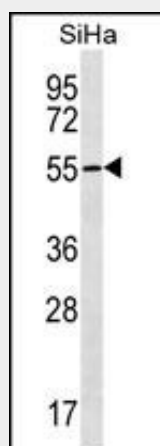

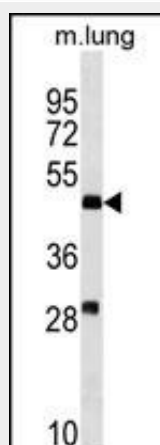

RNF150 Antibody (N-term) - Background

RNF150 contains a RING-type zinc finger, a motif known to be involved in protein-protein and protein-DNA interactions. The specific function of this protein is unknown.
