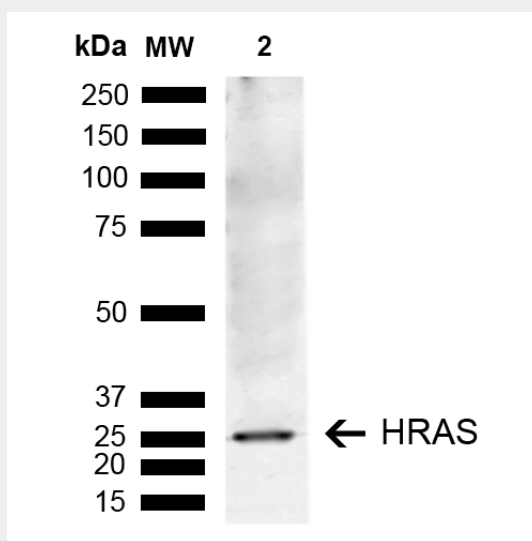

Lane 1: Molecular Weight Ladder (MW). Lane 2: A549. Load: 10 μ g. Block: 5% Skim Milk in 1X TBST. Primary Antibody: Rabbit Anti-HRAS Polyclonal Antibody (SPC-776) at 1:1000 for 2 hours at RT. Secondary Antibody: Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG: HRP at 1:5000 for 1 hour at RT. Color Development: ECL solution for 5 min at RT. Predicted/Observed Size: ~21.3 kDa. Other Band(s): 25 kDa.
