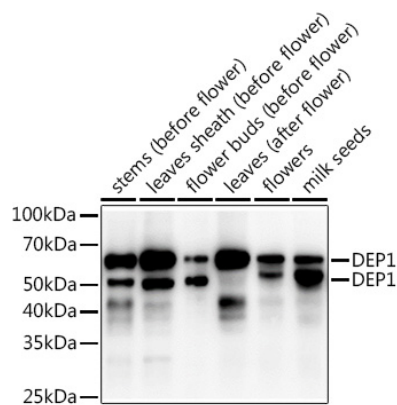

Western blot analysis of extracts of various tissues from the japonica rice (*Oryza sativa* L.) variety Zhonghua 11, using DEP1 Rabbit pAb (A19181) at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (AS014) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25µg per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Enhanced Kit (RM00021). Exposure time: 30s.
