Formulation

Lyophilized from a 0.22 μm filtered solution of 50mM Tris,10mM CaCl₂,150mM NaCl, pH 7.5.Contact us for customized product form or formulation.

Reconstitution

Centrifuge the vial before opening. Reconstitute to a concentration of 0.1-0.5 mg/mL in sterile distilled water. Avoid vortex or vigorously pipetting the protein. For long term storage, it is recommended to add a carrier protein or stabilizer (e.g. 0.1% BSA, 5% HSA, 10% FBS or 5% Trehalose), and aliquot the reconstituted protein solution to minimize free-thaw cycles.

Basic Information

Description

Recombinant Rat MMP-9 Protein is produced by HEK293 cells expression system. The target protein is expressed with sequence (Leu35-Pro708) of rat MMP-9 (Accession #NP_038627.1.) fused with a 6×His tag at the C-terminus.

Bio-Activity

1.Measured in a cell migration assay using Hela cells. 1 ng/mL of Recombinant Rat MMP-9 can effectively induce Hela cells migration.|2.Measured by its ability to cleave the fluorogenic peptide substrate Mca-PLGL-Dpa-AR-NH₂. The specific activity is >1600 pmoles/min/μg.

Storage

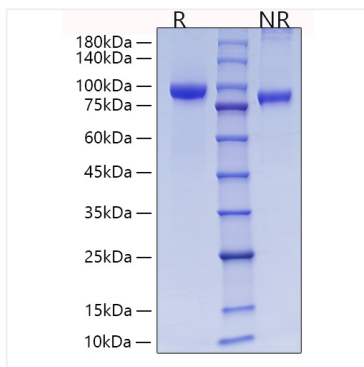
Store at -20°C.Store the lyophilized protein at -20°C to -80 °C up to 1 year from the date of receipt.
After reconstitution, the protein solution is stable at -20°C for 3 months, at 2-8°C for up to 1 week. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

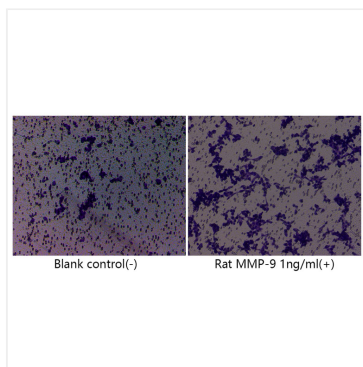
