## **Formulation**

Lyophilized from a 0.22 µm filtered solution of PBS, pH 7.4.

#### Reconstitution

Centrifuge the vial before opening. Reconstitute to a concentration of 0.1-0.5 mg/mL in sterile distilled water. Avoid vortex or vigorously pipetting the protein. For long term storage, it is recommended to add a carrier protein or stablizer (e.g. 0.1% BSA, 5% HSA, 10% FBS or 5% Trehalose), and aliquot the reconstituted protein solution to minimize free-thaw cycles.

## **Background**

This protein is a major apoprotein of the chylomicron. It binds to a specific liver and peripheral cell receptor, and is essential for the normal catabolism of triglyceride-rich lipoprotein constituents. This gene maps to chromosome 19 in a cluster with the related apolipoprotein C1 and C2 genes. Mutations in this gene result in familial dysbetalipoproteinemia, or type III hyperlipoproteinemia (HLP III), in which increased plasma cholesterol and triglycerides are the consequence of impaired clearance of chylomicron and VLDL remnants.

#### Description

Recombinant Human Apolipoprotein E/ApoE Protein is produced by HEK293 cells expression system. The target protein is expressed with sequence (Lys19-His317) of human Apolipoprotein E/ApoE (Accession #NP\_000032.1) fused with a 6×His tag at the C-terminus.

## **Bio-Activity**

Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA.Immobilized Human ApoE (Catalog: RP01443) at 5ug/mL (100  $\mu L/well$ ) can bind Human TREM2 (Catalog: RP01159) with a linear range of 0.6-65 ng/mL .

#### **Storage**


Store at -20°C. Store the lyophilized protein at -20°C to -80 °C up to 1 year from the date of receipt.

After reconstitution, the protein solution is stable at -20°C for 3 months, at 2-8°C for up to 1 week.


Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
