

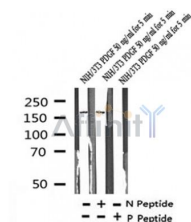

Purification:	The Ab is from purified rabbit serum by affinity purification via sequential chromatography on phospho- and non-phospho-peptide affinity columns.
Specificity:	Phospho-PDGF Receptor beta (Tyr751) Ab detects endogenous levels of PDGF Receptor beta only when phosphorylated at Tyr751.
Immunogen:	A synthesized peptide derived from human PDGF Receptor beta around the phosphorylation site of Tyr751.
Uniprot:	P09619
Subcellular Location:	Membrane.
Similarity:	Belongs to the protein kinase superfamily. Tyr protein kinase family. CSF-1/PDGF receptor subfamily.
Storage Condition and Buffer:	Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline , pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.Store at -20 °C.Stable for 12 months from date of receipt.



Western blot analysis of Phospho-PDGF Receptor beta (Tyr751) in lysates of NIH/3T3 PDGF 50 ng/ml for 5 min, using Phospho-PDGF Receptor beta (Tyr751) Ab(AF4398).

IMPORTANT: For western blot, incubate membrane with diluted primary Ab in 5% w/v milk , 1X TBS, 0.1% Tween@20 at 4°C with gentle shaking, overnight.

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
