

## **Rat Monoclonal anti Mouse Vitronectin**

**Preparation:** This antibody was produced from a hybridoma (mouse myeloma fused with spleen cells from a rat immunized with recombinant mouse Vitronectin. Vitronectin is a 71 kDa secreted glycoprotein produced by the liver and tumor cells.

**Formulation and Storage:** The IgG fraction of culture supernatant was purified by Protein G affinity chromatography and lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution in phosphate-buffered saline (PBS). Lyophilized samples are stable for 2 years from date of receipt when stored at -70°C.

**Reconstitution:** Reconstitute the antibody with 500ul sterile PBS and the final concentration is 200ug/ml. Reconstituted antibody can also be aliquoted and stored frozen at <-20 for at least for six months without detectable loss of activity. **Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.**

**Specificity:** This antibody recognizes mouse Vitronectin by direct ELISAs and WBs.
