Synonyms	Tamm-Horsfall urinary glycoprotein, THP, FJHN, HNFJ, THGP, MCKD2, ADMCKD2, UMOD, Uromodulin.
Description	Porcine Uromodulin is a 97kDa glycoprotein which is produced in the thick ascending limb of Henle's loop and early distal convoluted tubules of the nephron.

Source	Porcine Urine.
Physical Appearance and Stability	Filtered White Iyophilized (freeze-dried) powder. Store Iyophilized protein at -20°C. Aliquot the product after reconstitution to avoid repeated freezing/thawing cycles. Reconstituted protein can be stored at 4°C for a limited period of time; it does not show any change after two weeks at 4°C.
Formulation and Purity	The UMOD protein was lyophilized from 0.4µm filtered solution at a concentration of 0.5mg/ml containing deionized water.
Application	
Solubility	Add deionized water to prepare a working stock solution of approximately 0.5mg/mL and let the lyophilized pellet dissolve completely. Product is not sterile! Please filter the product by an appropriate sterile filter before using it in the cell culture.
Biological Activity	
Shipping Format and Condition	Lyophilized powder at room temperature.
