

## Leptin Rat Recombinant

<b>Item Number</b>	rAP-2336
<b>Synonyms</b>	OB Protein, Obesity Protein, OBS, Obesity factor.
<b>Description</b>	Leptin Rat Recombinant produced in E.Coli is a single, non-glycosylated, polypeptide chain containing 147 amino acids and having a molecular mass of 16 kDa. The Leptin is purified by proprietary chromatographic techniques.
<b>Uniprot Accession Number</b>	P50596
<b>Amino Acid Sequence</b>	The sequence of the first five N-terminal amino acids was determined and was found to be Ala-Val-Pro-Ile-His.
<b>Source</b>	Escherichia Coli.
<b>Physical Appearance and Stability</b>	Sterile Filtered White lyophilized (freeze-dried) powder. Lyophilized Leptin although stable at room temperature for 3 weeks, should be stored desiccated below -18°C. Upon reconstitution Leptin should be stored at 4°C between 2-7 days and for future use below -18°C. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA). Please prevent freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Formulation and Purity</b>	The protein was lyophilized from a concentrated (1mg/ml) solution with 0.0045mM NaHCO <sub>3</sub> . Greater than 95.0% as determined by: (a) Analysis by SEC-HPLC. (b) Analysis by SDS-PAGE.
<b>Application</b>	
<b>Solubility</b>	It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized Leptin in sterile 18MΩ-cm H <sub>2</sub> O not less than 100µg/ml, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions.
<b>Biological Activity</b>	Biological activity of Leptin Rat is evidenced by inducing proliferation of BAF/3 cells stably transfected with the long form of human leptin receptor.
<b>Shipping Format and Condition</b>	Lyophilized powder at room temperature.
