Sterile Filtered colorless solution. Store at 4°C if entire vial will be used within 2-4 weeks. Store, frozen at -20°C for longer periods of time For long term storage it is recommended to add a

carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA). Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.

The SH2D1A solution (1 mg/ml) contains 20mM Tris-HCl Buffer (pH 7.5), 1mM DTT and 10% Glycerol. Formulation and Purity
