Physical Appearance

and Stability

Sterile Filtered White lyophilized (freeze-dried) powder. Lyophilized Calcitonin although stable at room temperature for 3 weeks, should be stored desiccated below -18°C. Upon reconstitution CGRP should be stored at 4°C between 2-7 days and for future use below -18°C. For long term storage it is recommended to

add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA). Please prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

The calcitonin peptide was lyophilized with no additives. Greater than 98.0% as determined by:(a) Analysis Formulation and Purity

by RP-HPLC.(b) Analysis by SDS-PAGE.

Application

Solubility It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized Calcitonin in sterile 18MΩ-cm H2O not less than 100 μg/

ml, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions.

Biological Activity

Shipping Format and Condition Lyophilized powder at room temperature.
