Details

Purification Method	Chickens were immunized with purified, non-denatured rabbit IgG (containing both heavy and light chains). Eggs were collected from hyperimmunized hens and the IgY fraction purified from the yolks. Anti-rabbit IgG's were affinity-purified over a column conjugated with purified rabbit IgG (containing both heavy and light chains).
Specificity	H&L; there is no detectable cross-reactivity with goat, human or mouse IgG.
Quality Control Tests	Antibodies were tested for specificity using double-immunodiffusion in agarose.
Storage and Stability	Store at 4°C in the dark. Under these conditions, the antibodies should have a shelf life of at least twelve months, provided they remain sterile. For longer term storage, aliquot and freeze to avoid freeze-thaw of the antibody.
