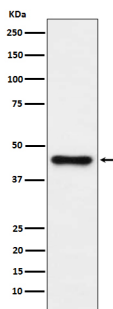

Storage Instructions	Store at -20°C for one year. For short term storage and frequent use, store at 4°C for up to one month. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Technical Details

Immunogen	A synthesized peptide derived from human ABHD5 Lysophosphatidic acid acyltransferase which functions in phosphatidic acid biosynthesis. May regulate the cellular storage of triacylglycerol through activation of the phospholipase PNPLA2. Involved in keratinocyte differentiation.
Isotype	Rabbit IgG
Form	Liquid
Concentration	Actual concentration vary by lot. Use suggested dilution ratio to decide dilution procedure.
Purification	Affinity-chromatography
Suggested Dilutions	Dilute the sample so that the expected range of concentrations fall within the detection range of this kit. If the expected range of concentration is unknown, a pilot test should be conducted to decide the optimal dilution ratio for your samples.
