Description: The mouse monocloanal antibody recognizes human Vascular Cell Adhesion Molecule 1

(VCAM1/CD106), a member of the Ig superfamily. VCAM1 is a cell surface

sialoglycoprotein expressed by cytokine-activated endothelium. This type I membrane protein mediates leukocyte-endothelial cell adhesion and signal transduction, and may

play a role in the development of artherosclerosis and rheumatoid arthritis.

Specificity: Recognizes the Vascular Cell Adhesion Molecule-1 (VCAM-1), a 110 kDa protein.

Biological Activity: Blocks the cell attachment to VCAM1.


Formulation: Liquid in PBS. Sterile-filtered. Carrier and preservative free.

Storage & Stability: Stable at 2-8°C for 1 year. For longer storage, freeze aliquots at -20 to -80°C. Avoid

repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
