


Purified Rabbit Anti-mouse Eotaxin

Description:	For research use only. This polyclonal antibody, which reacts with recombinant and natural mouse eotaxin, was generated using E. coli-expressed amino acid 1-74 of mature mouse eotaxin as an immunogen. Eotaxin is a 74-amino acid eosinophil-chemotactic CC chemokine originally found in bronchoalveolar lavage fluid from allergic inflammatory subjects. It is involved in regulating the recruitment and activation of inflammatory leukocytes, particularly eosinophils. It may play a fundamental role in the development of allergic responses.

Immunogen:	Eotaxin		
lsotype:	lgG		
Formulation:	Protein A purified rabbit IgG, 500 μg, with 0.1% sodium azide, lyophilized.		
Reconstitution:	Reconstitute to 1 mg/ml by adding 500 μl PBS.		
Cross-Reactivity:	Reacts with recombinant and natural mouse eotaxin. Cross-reactivity to eotaxin of other species has not been determined.		
Applications:	The tested titer for Western blot is 1:2,000.		
Storage & Stability:	4°C for short term storage or -20°C in small aliquots for long term storage. Avoid repeated freeze and thaw cycles.
