

Human Low Density Lipoprotein, APO-B, clone 12G10, Monoclonal Antibody

Specificity

The antibody reacts with low density lipoproteins of human plasma. It is specific for fragment T4, the amino terminal thrombolytic peptide of human apo-B. No cross-reactions with other human plasma proteins were detected.

Immunoglobulin type

Murine IgG₁

Use

The antibody can be used for LDL depletion of human plasma, in combination with other mabs for detection of LDL in plasma and for the specific detection of apo-B. The antibody is also useful for detection of apo-B in tissue sections.

Instructions for use

The antibody can be used in ELISA techniques (dilute approx. 1:1000) and in immunohistology on frozen sections (dilute 1:100). For depletion experiments the antibody should be used in a solid phase system.

Presentation

1 ml lyophilized purified Ig solution with approximately 0.5mg antibody/ml. Sufficient for staining of 100 frozen sections. Reconstitute with 1 ml. sterile water and add preservative if preferred.

Method of purification

Sodium sulfate + DEAE-cellulose, gradient elution.
