Immunogen: Calcitonin gene-related peptide (synthetic, rat) conjugated to BSA. Tested on human and

rat tissues.

Formulation: 50 μl undiluted, freeze-dried antiserum. Dissolve the antiserum in 50-100 μL distilled

water, and dilute further in 0.1M PBS with 1% BSA and 0.1% NaN₃.

Applications: Works on: Paraffin and frozen sections. 1:800-1:1500 using FITC, with overnight

incubation at +4°C.
