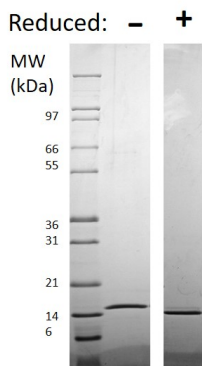

Description:	CD40 Ligand (CD40L) is a 261 amino acid type II transmembrane glycoprotein belonging to the TNF family. CD40L is expressed predominantly on activated CD4+ T lymphocytes, and also found in other types of cells, like NK cells, mast cells, basophils and eosinophils. Soluble CD40L is released from platelets. Soluble CD40L can bind its receptor, CD40, in monomeric, dimeric and trimeric forms, though the trimeric form of soluble CD40L has the most potent biological activity. CD40, is expressed on B lymphocytes, monocytes, dendritic cells and thymic epithelium. CD40L-CD40 interaction stimulates B cell proliferation, isotype switching, and secretion of all immunoglobulin isotypes in the presence of cytokines. It also plays important roles in monocyte activation and dendritic cell maturation.

Reconstitution:	Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Add sterile distilled water to a concentration of 0.1 mg/ml. DO NOT VORTEX. Allow several minutes for complete reconstitution. Further dilutions should be made in appropriate buffered solutions.		



Storage & Stability:

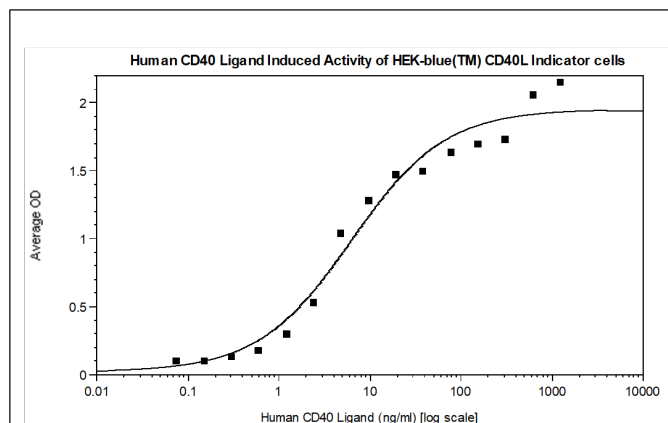
Store as supplied at -20°C to -80°C for up to 1 year. Upon reconstitution, prepare working aliquots and store at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that a carrier protein such as 0.1% HSA or BSA is added for long term storage.

Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
