**Description:** Haptoglobin is a protein in the blood plasma that binds free hemoglobin released from

erythrocytes with high affinity and thereby inhibits its oxidative activity. The haptoglobinhemoglobin complex will then be removed by the reticuloendothelial system (mostly the spleen). Haptoglobin is a serum protein that consists of two alpha and two beta chains connected by disulfide bridges. It acts as a hemoglobin scavenger and has been

associated with protease inhibitory activity.
