Flaviviridae.

A closely related virus in Far Eastern Eurasia, Russian spring-summer encephalitis virus

(RSSEV).

The family Flaviviridae includes other tick-borne viruses are closely related to TBEV and

RSSEV, such as Omsk hemorrhagic fever virus & Kyasanur Forest virus.

Louping ill virus is also a member of this family.

The E. coli derived recombinant protein contains the Tick-borne Encephalitis Virus core

protein epitopes.

Formulation: 20 mM MES, pH 6.5 + 8M urea + 200 mM NaCl & 0.05% Tween-20.

Purity: Encephalitis protein is >95% pure as determined by 10% PAGE (coomassie staining).

Purification Method: Encephalitis protein was purified by proprietary chromatographic technique.

Specific Activity: Immunoreactive with sera of encephalitis virus infected individuals.

Storage & Stability: Encephalitis protein although stable at 4°C for 1 week,

should be stored below -18°C.

Please prevent freeze thaw cycles.

Applications: Encephalitis antigen is suitable for ELISA and Western blots, excellent antigen for
