

BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY:

RP-54745 is an inhibitor of macrophage stimulation and **interleukin-1** production, and a potential antirheumatic compound. **In Vitro:** RP-54745 diminishes LPS-induced interleukin-1 (IL-1) production by murine peritoneal macrophages^[1]. **In Vivo:** RP-54745 (5 mg/kg) is effective at moderating oral doses in different mouse models of induced arthritis and in the MRL/lpr mice, genetically predisposed to develop an autoimmune pathology including arthritic disorders. The clinical status of the MRL mice, and several of their disturbed biochemical and immunological parameters, improved after a 3-month treatment with RP-54745^[2].
