<b>Product Overview</b>	Recombinant Mouse Alcam protein(NP_033785.1)(Met1-Lys527), fused with His tag, was expressed in HEK293.

<b>Bio-activity</b>	Immobilized mouse ALCAM-His at 10 µg/ml (100 µl/well) can bind mouse CD6-Fc, The EC50 of mouse CD6-Fc is 0.08-0.18 µg/ml.
<b>Molecular Mass</b>	The recombinant mouse ALCAM consists of 511 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 57.7 kDa. Due to glycosylation, rmALCAM migrates as an approximately 70-80 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
<b>Proteinlength</b>	Met1-Lys527
<b>Endotoxin</b>	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method

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<b>Purity</b>	> 98 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
<b>Storage</b>	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Reconstitution</b>	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
