Intended Use

Quantitative determination of Rat E-Selectin

General Description

ABPR-ZB227 is a solid phase sandwich ELISA for quantitative determination of Rat E-Selectin.

Reagents And Materials Provided

1. Capture Antibody: 0.4 mg/mL of rabbit anti-Rat E-Selectin/CD62e/SELE monoclonal antibody [CABT-ZB648] (in PBS, pH 7.4).
2. Detection Antibody: 0.5 mg/mL of rabbit anti-Rat E-Selectin/CD62e/SELE monoclonal antibody [CABT-ZB991] conjugated to HRP (in PBS, 50 % glycerol, pH 7.4).
3. Standard: Each vial contains 33 ng of recombinant Rat E-Selectin/CD62e/SELE.

Reconstitution And Storage

Reconstitution

1. Capture Antibody: Dilute to a working concentration of 2 µg/mL in PBS before coating.
2. Detection Antibody: Dilute to working concentration of 0.5 µg/mL in detection antibody dilution buffer before use.
3. Standard: Reconstitute with 1 mL detection antibody dilution buffer.

Storage

1. Capture Antibody: Aliquot and store at -20°C to -80°C for up to 6 months from date of receipt. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
2. Detection Antibody: Protect it from prolonged exposure to light. Aliquot and store at -20°C to -80°C and for up to 6 months from date of receipt. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
3. Standard: Store lyophilized standard at -20°C to -80°C for up to 6 months from date of receipt. Aliquot and store the reconstituted Standard at -80°C for up to 1 month. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Detection Range

Assay range: 18.8-1200 pg/mL
