BACKGROUND

Introduction	Human noroviruses (HuNoV) are the main cause of non-bacterial gastroenteritis worldwide, producing high morbidity and mortality rates. HuNoV belongs to the family Caliciviridae, specifically to the genus Norovirus, which has recently been subdivided into 10 different genogroups (GI–GX). Only GI, GII, and GIV infect and cause acute gastroenteritis in humans.
