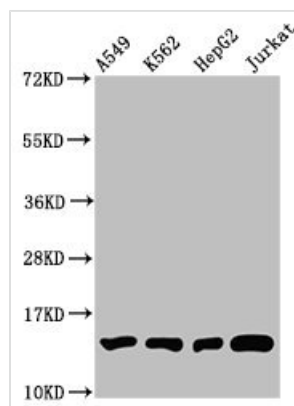

Positive WB detected in: A549 whole cell lysate, K562 whole cell lysate, HepG2 whole cell lysate, Jurkat whole cell lysate

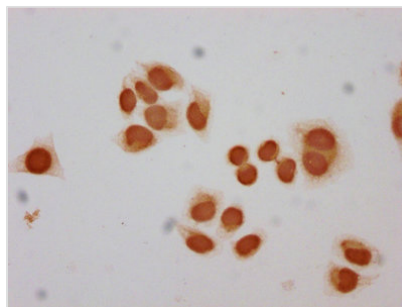
All lanes: HIST1H2BC antibody at 1:100

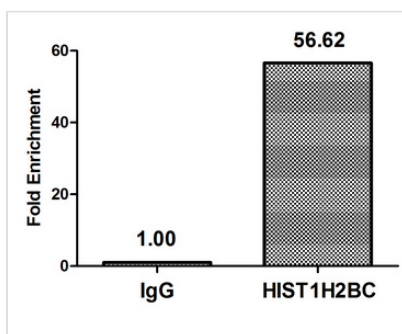
Goat polyclonal to rabbit IgG at 1/50000 dilution

Immunocytochemistry analysis of CSB-PA010403OA12me1HU diluted at 1:30 and staining in HeLa cells performed on a Leica BondTM system. The cells were fixed in 4% formaldehyde, permeabilized using 0.2% Triton X-100 and blocked with 10% normal goat serum 30min at RT. Then primary antibody (1% BSA) was incubated at 4°C overnight. The primary is detected by a biotinylated secondary antibody and visualized using an HRP conjugated SP system.



Chromatin Immunoprecipitation HeLa (4×10^6) were treated with Micrococcal Nuclease, sonicated, and immunoprecipitated with 5μg anti-HIST1H2BC (CSB-PA010403OA12me1HU) or a control normal rabbit IgG. The resulting ChIP DNA was quantified using real-time PCR with primers against the β-Globin promoter.
