<b>Immunogen</b>	The antiserum was produced against synthesized peptide derived from human ABCB10. AA range:441-490
<b>Specificity</b>	ABCB10 Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of ABCB10 protein.
<b>Formulation</b>	Liquid in PBS containing 50% glycerol, 0.5% BSA and 0.02% sodium azide.
<b>Storage</b>	Store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Protein Name</b>	ATP-binding cassette sub-family B member 10 mitochondrial
<b>Gene Name</b>	ABCB10
<b>Cellular localization</b>	Mitochondrion inner membrane ; Multi-pass membrane protein .




## Background

The membrane-associated protein encoded by this gene is a member of the superfamily of ATP-binding cassette (ABC) transporters. ABC proteins transport various molecules across extra- and intra-cellular membranes. ABC genes are divided into seven distinct subfamilies (ABC1, MDR/TAP, MRP, ALD, OABP, GCN20, White). This protein is a member of the MDR/TAP subfamily. Members of the MDR/TAP subfamily are involved in multidrug resistance. The function of this mitochondrial protein is unknown. Western Blot analysis of various cells using ABCB10 Polyclonal Antibody




Western blot analysis of lysates from COLO cells, using ABCB10 Antibody. The lane on the right is blocked with the synthesized peptide.
