Background: SYT1. synaptotagmin I. The synaptotagmins are integral membrane proteins of synaptic

vesicles thought to serve as Ca(2+) sensors in the process of vesicular trafficking and exocytosis. Calcium binding to synaptotagmin I participates in triggering neurotransmitter

release at the synapse.




Figure 1. Western blot analysis using SYT1 mouse mAb against truncated Trx-SYT1 recombinant protein (1).
