Storage/Stability: Store at -20°C/1 year

Form of Antibody: Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline (without Mg^{2+} and Ca^{2+}), pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.

Immunogen: The antiserum was produced against synthesized phosphopeptide derived from human ZAP-70 around the phosphorylation site of tyrosine 292 (D-G-Y^P-T-P).

Purification: The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific phosphopeptide. The antibody against non-phosphopeptide was removed by chromatography using non-phosphopeptide corresponding to the phosphorylation site.

Specificity: ZAP-70 (Phospho-Tyr292) antibody detects endogenous levels of ZAP-70 only when phosphorylated at tyrosine 292.
