



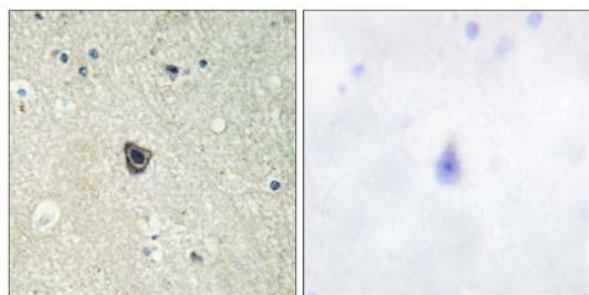

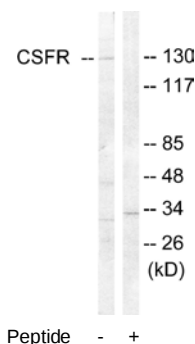

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Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin-embedded human brain tissue using CSFR (Ab-809) antibody.



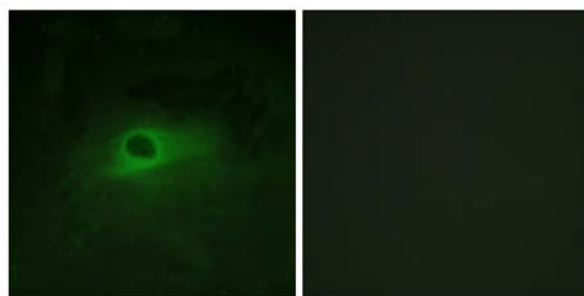
