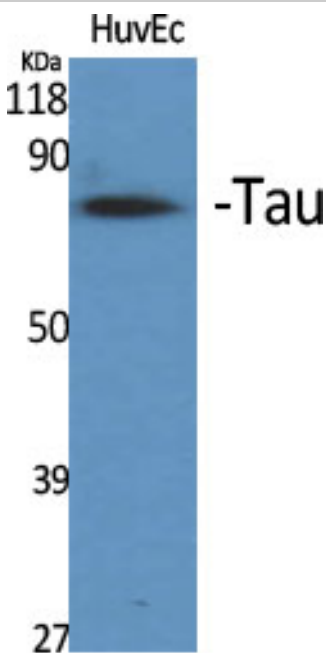

Specificity/Sensitivity:	Tau Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of Tau protein.
