

CX3CR1Polyclonal Antibody

Background: Fractalkine is a transmembrane protein and chemokine involved in the adhesion and

migration of leukocytes. The protein encoded by this gene is a receptor for fractalkine. The encoded protein also is a coreceptor for HIV-1, and some variations in this gene lead to increased susceptibility to HIV-1 infection and rapid progression to AIDS. Four transcript

variants encoding two different isoforms have been found for this gene.

Storage/Stability: Store at -20oC or -80oC. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles. Buffer: PBS with 0.02% sodium azide,

50% glycerol, pH7.3.
