**Storage/Stability:**Lyophilized protein should be stored at < -20°C, though stable at room temperature for 3 weeks. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-7°C for 2-7 days. Aliquots of reconstituted samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.

**Background:**Interleukin-8 (IL-8) belongs to the neutrophil-specific CXC family of chemokines. It is one of the initial cytokines released from a variety of cell types, including T cells, endothelial cells and fibroblasts, in response to an inflammatory stimulus and acts by recruiting neutrophils, T-cells and basophils to the site of inflammation. Elevated Interleukin-8 levels are associated with the onset of a variety of disease states.

**Species:**Human

**Reconstitution:**Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting. It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than 100 µg/ml. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in ddH2O. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

**Endotoxin:**Less than 0.1 ng/µg (1 IEU/µg) as determined by LAL test.

**Purity:**Greater than 95% as determined by reducing SDS-PAGE.

**Description:**Recombinant Human C-X-C motif chemokine 8/Interleukin 8 is produced by our Mammalian expression system and the target gene encoding Glu21-Ser99 is expressed with a 6His tag at the C-terminus.

**Product State:**Lyophilized

**Ship Description:**The product is shipped at ambient temperature.

**Formulation:**Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution of 20mM PB,150mM NaCl,pH7.4.

**Expression system:**Human cells
